Refurbishing the Shrine Emblems

Just who is this Patsy Parker and why does she keep messing with our stuff?

Well, she was introduced to the world of Khedive when she began bringing Jim Evans (Oceanview Shrine Club) to Club and Temple meetings when he reluctantly gave up driving. She was an extended family member who lived around the corner and volunteered to be his chauffeur. Patsy was almost as proud as “Uncle Jimmy” when he was awarded his 70 Year Shrine Pin! He certainly was proud of the Khedive Shrine and loved his Shrine brothers.

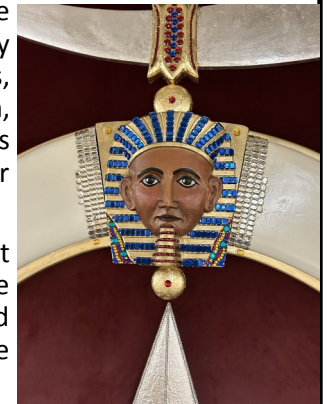


Patsy is a retired art teacher from Norfolk Public Schools with an MA in sculpture who decided to step up and create a replacement for the emblem that was located on a side wall in the ballroom. The reincarnated emblem is now over the double doors in the Temple foyer. The face of the original sequin and rhinestone emblem is folded and tucked into the crown of the new emblem.

She announced she was interested in refurbishing the largest emblem on the stage when 3 joint replacements slowed down her progress. While recuperating, Potentate Mark Cook contacted her about his brainstorm of creating staging for the Arch Ceremony. (A chance to make sculpture! Yes!) Of course, she agreed, and large cardboard boxes textured with sand took over the dining room table. Khedive is now the proud owner of a stage property that few Temples have for their Installation Ceremony.



After a hiatus, Patsy was now ready to resume her quest to refurbish the emblem on the ballroom stage. Burgundy upholstery velvet (to match more closely the fezzes) now covers the original Christmas red velvet background. The split in the carved wooden face has been repaired, its complexion has been “brightened” and the eyes made slightly larger. Since Shrine history dates to 1870, it is understandable that symbols have evolved after the discovery in King Tutankhamun’s tomb in 1922, the emblem’s crown is now more regal and more historically accurate. Taking a hint from the bejeweled Khedive fezzes, sparkle was added to enhance specific aspects of the crown, beard, collar, scimitar, and claws. Leftover antique rhinestones



from the original emblem after finishing the replacement emblem in the foyer found their way to trim out the Star.

Please thank the Tidewater Shrine Club for generously funding the materials used in this last endeavor. “Uncle Jimmy” loved them almost as much as his Oceanview Shrine Club. Please pat Harry Tew on the back as he never failed to make a space in his schedule and appeared when I needed his expertise. Also, please pat Alan Brown on the back for bringing more muscle to assist Harry on the final installation of the emblem on the back wall of the stage.

If it had not been for Jim Evans, I would not have had the pleasure to serve Khedive Shrine! Thank you!

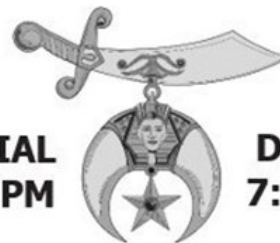

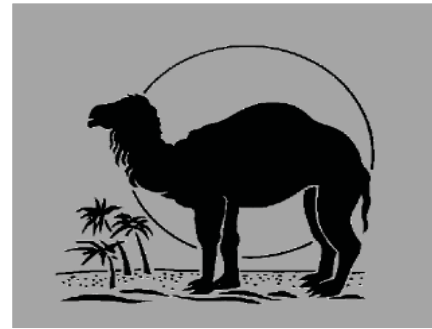
