

After the patient arrives at one of our hospitals, our incredible doctors and nurses develop a treatment plan for the child. They share what to expect with the family and continue to partner with them throughout the healing journey. Lady Judy knows firsthand that this gives the family a sense of relief that our providers will do the very best to help their child return to their daily lives as quickly as possible. Parents play a large part, as well, in caring for the child. Shriners Children's is a special place where compassionate nurses, care managers, therapists and physicians care for the whole family as much as the child.

#### WRAPAROUND SUPPORT SERVICES

Shriners Children's has the resources to support patients throughout their treatment, including occupational, physical and child life therapy, scar management, prosthetics and orthotics. They also focus on the emotional healing that comes after a burn injury. Patients have access to psychological services as well as school and community re-entry programs to help children adjust to life outside the hospital.

# Shriners Children's: A History of Innovation and Excellence in Burn Care

Shriners Children's<sup>™</sup> is noted worldwide as a leader in pediatric burn care. Since opening our first pediatric burns hospitals in the 1960s, our healthcare system has been at the forefront of innovative programs and treatment techniques that have both dramatically improved the survival rate for children with severe burns and enhanced their quality of life. Here is a brief look at our work over the decades:

### **1960**s

The governing body of the Shriners organization passed a resolution at the Imperial Session in 1962 to build and operate hospitals specializing in pediatric burn care. The first hospital opened in 1962 in Galveston, Texas, followed by additional specialized hospitals in Cincinnati, Ohio, and Boston, Massachusetts, two years later.

### **1970**s

Tremendous improvements in survival rates were made, particularly because of innovative research in excision, grafting and intravenous feeding. In addition, pressure garments that helped lessen scarring were developed at the Galveston hospital. Our Cincinnati hospital pioneered skin banking – a precursor to future methods of tissue, bone and skin procurement. In addition, Shriners Children's worked with the United States Fire Administration and Consumer Product Safety Commission to identify burn prevention programs for schools and fire departments. And, our Boston hospital began the first school re-entry program.

### **1980**s

Outpatient clinics were added to provide continued care for patients after they have been discharged from the hospital. Researchers at Shriners Children's discovered that early surgical excision of injured tissue and grafting reduces infections, shortens hospital stays and improves cosmetic outcomes for patients. Shriners Children's became leaders in burn prevention, collaborating with the American Burn Association to promote Burn Awareness Week, a national education campaign created to raise public awareness and reduce the number of burn injuries in children.

### **1990**s

Treatments became available for non-burn conditions such as port wine stains, congenital ear deformities and other complex wound and skin conditions. In addition, new programs were set up to help burn patients with psychological and social issues, including transitioning back to school and community. In 1996, Shriners Children's Boston collaborated with the American Burn Association to develop an outcome instrument to measure functional outcomes in pediatric burn survivors. And, in 1997, Shriners Children's Northern California opened in Sacramento and soon became the busiest pediatric burn center in the Western United States.

### **2000**s

Our hospitals in Boston and Cincinnati received the Press Ganey Summit Award for extraordinary patient satisfaction. All four of the hospitals were recognized as leaders in the field of burn care, with each hospital maintaining a leadership position with the American Burn Association. Shriners Children's Boston, through microfluidics research, developed a microchip device that aids therapeutic strategies for burn patients.

### **2010**s

In 2011, Shriners Children's Northern California hosted its first Regional Burn Conference, a continuing education program for physicians, nurses, first responders, therapists and other healthcare professionals. In 2014, David Herndon, M.D., chief of staff in our Texas hospital, was awarded the Medallion for Scientific Achievement by the American Surgical Association and the Tanner-Vanderput-Boswick Burn Prize from the International Society for Burn Injuries. In 2015, John Burke, M.D., former chief of staff at our Boston hospital, was inducted into the Inventors Hall of Fame posthumously for his work with the development of artificial skin. Shriners Children's achieved excellent results using CO2 fractional laser technology to increase function and improve the appearance of burn scars.

### **2020**s

In 2021, our Cincinnati hospital moved to Dayton, Ohio. Shriners Children's burns hospitals have continued to offer innovative plastic, laser and reconstructive treatments for patients, including care for complex craniofacial conditions. Our burn care teams have expanded their outreach to countries where burn injuries are more prevalent; international patients are also being treated at our facilities. Shriners Children's researchers continue to pioneer the latest advancements in burn care and conduct outcomes research to improve care for burn survivors.

Shriners Children's looks forward to continuing its legacy of leadership in pediatric burn care.

# Families seeking care for colorectal and gastrointestinal (GI) conditions come to Shriners Children's

Shriners Children's provides innovative and compassionate care for children with bowel disorders or those experiencing problems with their digestive systems. Trouble with bowel control can lead to struggles at home, in school, in friendships, and with emotions, behavior and mental health. Many children can be more active, social, happy and independent if they have a plan for <u>bowel management</u>, with colorectal and gastrointestinal care that works specifically for them.



We bring specialists together to evaluate, diagnose and solve colorectal health issues, from bowel management and motility problems to complex conditions such as Hirschsprung disease, <u>inflammatory bowel disease</u> and <u>anorectal malformations</u>. We offer long-term care for patients with conditions that they may have been born with, as well as conditions that develop over time. Our ultimate goal is to help children heal, allowing them to enjoy life with the fewest limitations possible.

Our noted team of pediatric surgeons understands the physical and emotional impacts of colon and rectal diseases. They lead a multidisciplinary team of professionals who manage the entire range of care for patients of all ages. Whether it be <u>complex</u> surgery, medical management or social support, our team addresses the individual needs of each child.

When your child is seen in Shriners Children's for a colorectal or gastrointestinal condition, they receive the benefit of collaboration and care planning between <u>social workers</u>, <u>care managers</u>, <u>child life specialists</u>, nurses, <u>dietitians</u> and physicians. Teams run weekly meetings discussing all upcoming patients to make sure that each child receives the input of each of our team members.

In all cases, the goal is to care for the child's overall health and well-being, proving medical treatment while also setting patients on a path to independence by freeing them from the social stigmas that may leave them feeling ashamed, depressed and alone.

The key to success is dedication, timing and teamwork among the patient, families and medical team. We tailor each child's care plan to their specific needs to provide the best possible outcome.

### **About Our Pediatric Colorectal & GI Specialists**

Our pediatric specialists on the colorectal and gastrointestinal team care for many patients with colorectal health issues and rare colorectal conditions. They also participate in key consortiums and learning groups, and they contribute to <u>research</u> studies. Through collaboration with experts at other institutions, our staff has developed a greater understanding of conditions and innovative treatments, all to improve outcomes for children with colorectal disorders.

Our colorectal and gastrointestinal care teams are active members of the <u>Pediatric Colorectal and Pelvic Learning</u> <u>Consortium</u> (PCPLC), an international group dedicated to furthering research on anorectal malformations, Hirschsprung disease, and other colorectal and pelvic disorders.

### Distinguished Colorectal & Gastrointestinal (GI) Care Center in California

The colorectal and gastrointestinal care center located at <u>Shriner's Children's Northern California</u> is designated by California Children's Services (CCS) as a Special Care Center. It is the only CCS Special Care Center for pediatric colorectal and gastrointestinal care in California. Families throughout the nation travel to Sacramento for comprehensive, compassionate care.



# Shriners Children's offers an innovative approach for children who need surgery to reposition their jaws to improve bite and appearance.

3D printing for jaw surgeries involves taking three-dimensional X-rays of your child's face and using that information to perform a virtual surgery with computer-simulated software. This virtual surgery is also used to create a dental appliance that can be printed on one of our three dimensional printers. The dental appliance, called a bite splint, is an important tool used during your child's actual operation. Typically

occurring when they are an adolescent or young adult, jaw surgery can happen during an important time in your child's life. They could be getting ready to take their yearbook picture or photos for senior prom. At Shriners Children's, our use of three-dimensional tools will not only produce a better outcome from jaw surgery but will give your child back that confidence they need during those memorable moments.




